Reporter SP: New entry team in Sailingpass Regatta, how does it feel?

Skipper: **We are excited to join such a colorful fleet. We look forward to seeing what challenges the Sailingpass Regatta has in store for us.**

Reporter SP: Can you tell us something about your team?

Skipper: **We are a young team in terms of both age and experience, but we make up for our lack of experience with endurance, courage and enthusiasm. Our greatest strength is preparation, creativity and cohesion.**

Reporter SP: How did you prepare for the upcoming regatta?

Skipper: **As we only have the opportunity to spend a few days a year on water, we spend a lot of time analyzing, evaluating our own decisions, reviewing our own movement lines and trying to learn from more experienced sailors. Everyone has a specialty (like navigation, trimming, etc.) and that person is responsible to pass on the knowledge to the others in the form of a webinar. On the water, theory meets practice...**

Reporter: In 4 editions the Sailing Pass Regatta has had 4 winners, what do you think who will be in the 5th edition?

Skipper: **We will definitely win. Our main goal is to connect with as many people who love sailing as possible and to participate in exciting races in a good atmosphere. Sailing is a very complex sport. It is not enough for a team to work well together. You need to work in harmony with the forces of nature, you need to know your yacht and, of course, you need luck. In a multi-day regatta, the team that makes the fewest mistakes wins, because no one can complete a perfect week. We'd be happy to be one of the teams that makes the fewest mistakes at the end of the week.**
